Total area of lake and drainage, 36 square miles.

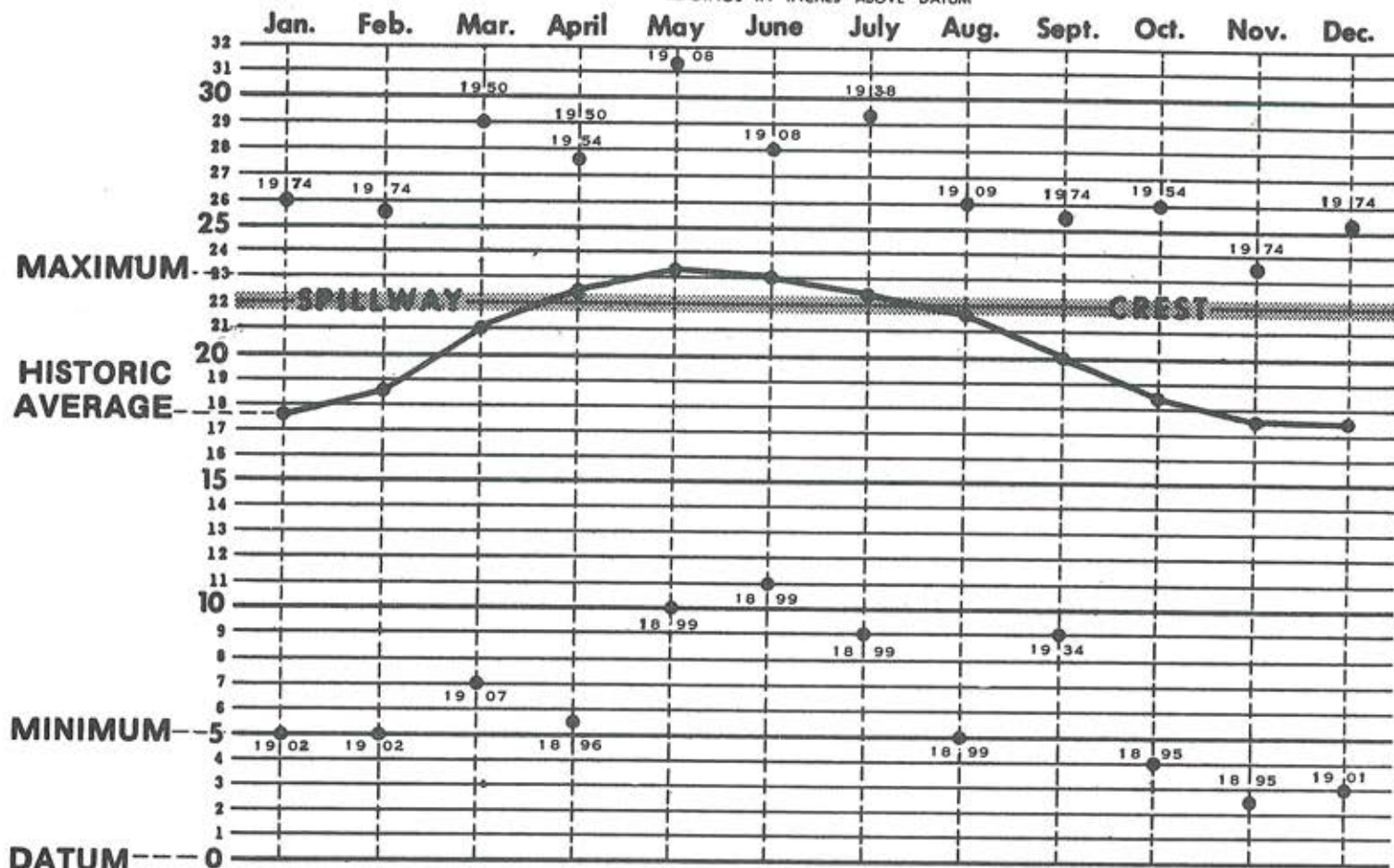
Area of lake 8.6 square miles.
