One inch of lake level equals 150 million gallons.

Area of lake is 8.6 square miles.

Total area of lake and drainage is 36 square miles.

Spillway is 864 feet above sea level.

Takes 24 hours to lower lake one inch.

Spillway crest is 22 inches above datum.
