Official gauge located in forebay on east end of spillway.

Spillway is 864.299 feet above sea level.

Spillway crest is 22 inches above datum.

Area of lake is 8.6 square miles or 5,231 acres

Total area of lake and drainage is 36 sq. miles or 13,121 acres

One inch of lake level equals 150 million gallons

It takes 24 hours to lower the lake one inch.

Retention time is 15 years.
